



Mentoring Ministry Agreement

Christian Mentoring Ministry is an ongoing relationship between a Mentoring Minister and a person who desires mentoring ministry.

Mentoring Ministry is discipleship to heal, equip, and go forward.

Mentoring Ministers are prepared to mentor and are equipped for inner healing prayer and deliverance ministry.

We Agree that:

The Ministry:

- Mentoring Ministry is a Christ Centered, Bible based, Holy Spirit led healing prayer ministry. Ministers are committed followers of Jesus Christ and seek to live according to this commitment serving under the guidelines of Sheep Shed Mentoring Ministry.
- Mentoring Ministry is not therapy, counseling, mental health care, or treatment for substance abuse.
- This Ministry is not intended as a replacement for counseling, psychiatric interventions, treatment for mental illness, professional medical advice, financial assistance, legal counsel, or other professional services. Referrals are made when these services are needed.
- Mentoring Ministry is designed to address issues the person being mentored would like to consider. These would include (but not limited to) relationship enhancement with God, others and themselves, spiritual growth, lifestyle management, life balance, decision-making, and achieving short-term or long-term goals.
- Mentoring Ministry can be an ongoing mentoring relationship that may take a number of months/years, although either party can terminate the relationship at any time. Notes taken during that time become the property of the person seeking this ministry except the Initial Contact Sheet that includes a record of the times met, a Hold Harmless Document, this Ministry Agreement, and a general description of the topic addressed for the records of the Mentoring Minister of Sheep Shed Mentoring Ministry. The host sending the person for ministry with the prior written consent of the person-receiving ministry can request a general report of ministry accomplished.
- Mentoring Ministry will involve prayer, listening, and a plan of action. It can involve daily Bible study, journaling, praise/worship, fasting, goal setting, accountability, examining lifestyle, etc.
- Agreement of the following will be made before or during the first meeting:
 - a.) Agreement of fees: \$75 per hour. Group or classes: \$25 for book and handouts, \$10 per hour.
